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Stewards Corner

Hello again, it's time for the **November Stewards Corner.** All the goblin's are gone, and now the gobbling begins. Yes Turkey Day is just weeks away. So I thought I might give you some tips on how to get that tender juicy turkey every time.

Tip#1 Try browning your turkey first instead of at the end of the cook time. Browning it first will seal in the juices, rather than at the end, when you lift that foil off, and all that steam comes rolling out, that was what would have been the juices in your turkey. Mold a piece of aluminum foil over the breast before you place the turkey in the oven. Remove the foil then place the turkey in the 2nd Election Day oven at 500 degrees for 1/2 hour then replace the aluminum foil on the turkey breast and continue roasting the turkey as you would normally. Slow roast 225 to 250 degrees, Quick roast 400 to 450 degrees, or French roast 325 to 350 degrees which ever you prefer. PS. (Cooking times will be different based upon the size of the bird and whether it is stuffed or unstuffed). Tip#2 Internal temperature should be at least 165 degrees and when the leg bone is pulled it should be very loose. Tip#3 You can also try to brine your turkey this will help as well. This is based on a scientific process called osmosis. Salt from the brine enters the turkey as the turkey's bodily fluids leave. The salt then helps to hold the moisture in the turkey during the cooking process. I hope this has helped you.


November 11, 2021 is Veterans Day we will have a special event at 12:30PM to honor all those who served in the service.
