Post Meetings

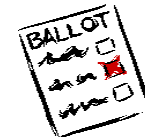

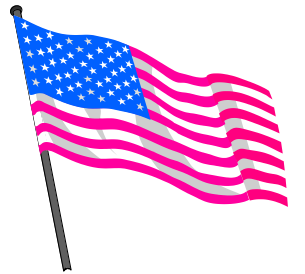


Auxiliary News
