

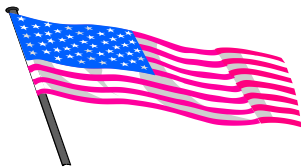

Another save the date event will be happening at St. Paul Lutheran Church on September 28,2024 for “Feed the Hunger”.

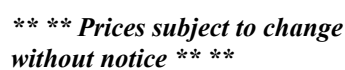


BINGO-BINGO-BINGO

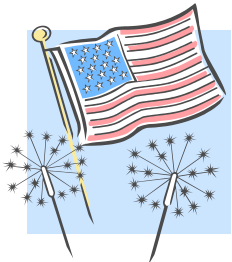
